NEW PROCEDURE FOR HPD ID CARDS

There is a new procedure for former members of the HPD to obtain their retired law enforcement ID card. The cards are still being issued by Transit Bureau but there is no longer a need to appear in person at Transit Bureau HQ in Brooklyn.

At least month before your card is due to expire (or if your card has already expired) call Housing Bureau at 212 432 2680 or 212 432 2461. Inform the PAA that you're calling to obtain a new HPD ID card. The PAA will ask you a series of questions and ask for a contact telephone number.

About a month later you will receive a call from Transit Bureau ID card section. You will have to email them a copy of your driver's license, your current ID card, and a digital photo of yourself from the waist up in front of a neutral colored background (no hats or sunglasses please).

After processing, a new ID card will be mailed to you via certified mail. If you have any questions, contact Transit Bureau at 718 610 4660 or email them at: TBHQPERSON-NEL@NYPD.org.
