PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



In the April 1, 1999 Record Rumors I wrote an article regarding the necessity for men to get a Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) test. Well thank God I heeded my own advice. of a conversation I recently had with a friend. When I informed him about my condition he asked how I became aware of it, I then mentioned the PSA test and he stated "what's that". Now that scared me. It's one thing if you choose not to be tested but entirely different not to have ever heard of the test. Remember early

stage Prostate Cancer has no symptoms, and when symptoms do occur it may be to late. It is the second leading cancer among men and kills more than 41,000 of our gender each year. So I am reiterating my warning and advise please, please get tested. By the way, like I said I don't want sympathy, but a couple of prayers wouldn't hurt. God Bless and Stay Well



Did I get your attention - I certainly hope so! If you are on Medicare, in August of each year, you should receive a Medicare Part B reimbursement check from the City. This year the check for a full year's reimbursement was for \$1156.80 per eligible member and/or eligible spouse. If you, and/or your spouse, are on Medicare and are not receiving this reimbursement you are giving this money to the City. To apply

for the reimbursement you must send a letter to the City with the following information:

1. Name of eligible person,
2. Address,
- 3.



4. Pension #,
5. Copy of letter from S/S telling you that you're eligible for Medicare,
6. Copy of Medicare

card (both sides), and
 7. Copy of S/S card (both sides).
 Send the letter with the above info to the Office of Labor Relations, NYC Employee Health Benefits Program, 40 Rector St. 3rd fl., NY, NY

10006, Attention: Medicare Reimbursement Unit.
 If (or when) your spouse is eligible, send the same info for him/her. This has to be done only

once. If for some reason you are eligible and have not already applied for the reimbursement you can still do it, and the City will go back several years. For more info go to www.nyc.gov/olr and select Health Care Benefits Program, then scroll down and select IRMAA pdf. If you do not have access to a computer you may contact the Health Benefits Program at the above address. Good Luck! Fraternally, Pat C.

FOP ID CARD RENEWAL

If you have an FOP ID card and want to renew it for 2011 here's how to do it:

1. Make sure you send in your dues for 2011. (If you are not a paid up member, they will not renew your ID card.)

2. Get an ID card renewal form from either the State

FOP web site (nysfop.org), or from the State FOP office.

3. Fill it out and send it to the NYS FOP at 911 Police Plaza, Hicksville, NY, 11801, along with payment (check with the State, 516 433 4455, for the cost). Note: Do not send it to our

lodge - send it directly to the State FOP.

4. The cards will not be issued until 2011. After the cards are printed, they will be sent directly to the members. If you do not have an FOP ID card and would like one, come to the election meeting

on Oct. 27th, or the luncheon on Dec. 1st (info on both events elsewhere in this newsletter), and have your photo taken, or contact the State FOP, number above, to make an appointment to take your photo.
